SHE: Deconstructing Female Identity

reflects on what it means to be a woman in contemporary America. In an age that so heavily emphasizes “the self,” ***SHE*** examines the idea that gender identity is constant balancing act between expected societal norms and self-definition.

The exhibiting artists eloquently and humorously engage with themes of self-presentation, a woman’s “proper space”, and feminine personas. Many of the works draw on objects identified with traditional notions of femininity, such as handbags, bras, doilies, and nail polish, transforming them into vehicles for thoughtful reflections on modern womanhood. ***SHE*** will debut several new works as well as commissions specifically for the exhibition.
